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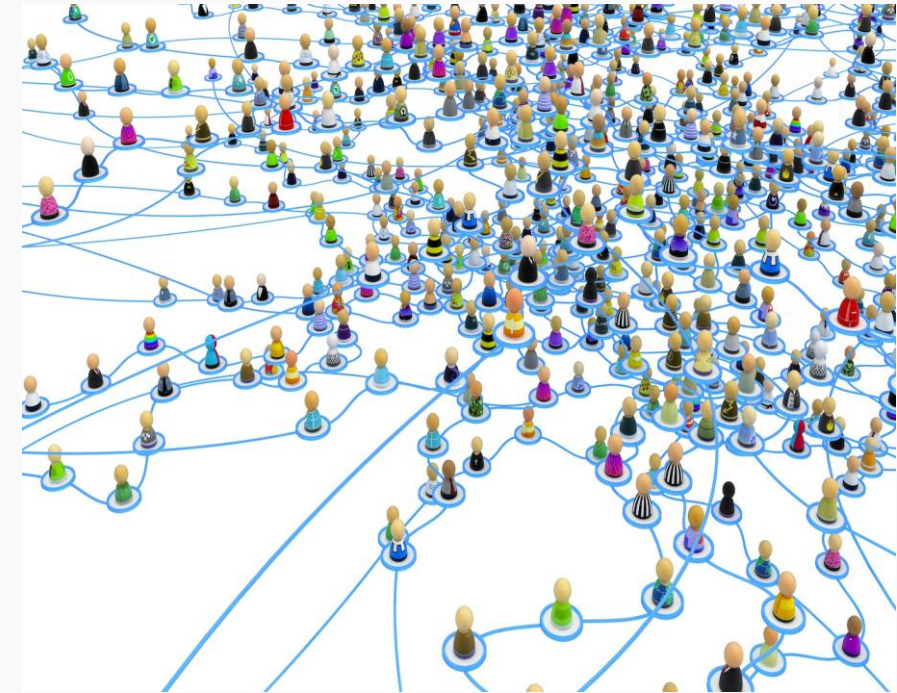
The impact of social media usage and lifestyle habits on academic achievement: Insights from a developing country context
